PHONICS

Reading and writing sessions will continue to follow the Read Write Inc scheme and will be tailored to your individual child's needs and ability. This will involve reviewing set 1 & 2 sounds and introducing set 3 sounds.

Common Exception words:

Grammar focus:

capital letters, full stops, finger spaces



THEME

In History our topic is called 'Burn and Build' which is centered around The Great Fire of London. The children will start to understand the concept of the past, key dates and events, significant people and changes over time.

After half term, our Theme focus will be Geography focusing on the United Kingdom and its key human and physical landmarks.



MATHS

We will start by reinforcing our understanding of numbers up to 10 and then use this to solve addition and subtraction calculations including number bonds and fact families. We will also learn to identify 2D and 3D shapes before beginning to look at the place value of numbers to 20.

SCIENCE

In our 'Seasons' topic, we will investigate the changes in Summer and Autumn. We will also study the topics of plants, animals and humans. We will learn how to identify different plants, and the five different groups of animals: mammals, birds, fish, reptiles and amphibians.
