MATHS

In Maths, we are consolidating concepts from Year 1 including naming, recognising and writing numbers to 20. We will revise place value (up to 100) and solve addition and subtraction problems. We will also learn to count in 2s, 3s, 5s and 10s. Towards the end of term, we will be naming and sorting 2D and 3D shapes. Within each area, the children are encouraged to find patterns and explain their reasoning.
