## HISTORY & SCIENCE

In Science, Year 6 will be studying 'Animals, including humans,' focusing on the human body and the importance of diet, exercise and a healthy lifestyle.



## MATHS

In Maths this term, we will be studying ratio, algebra & fractions, decimals and percentages.

As well as this, there will be a focus on reasoning and problem-solving-applying the mathematical concepts learnt within Key Stage 2. We will continue to regularly practice arithmetic skills.
