ENGLISH

The children have progressed well with their phonics, with some children completing the programme and moving into Comprehension and English groups. In reading, we will deepen our comprehension skills and learn how to infer, find evidence and summarise.

In writing, we will learn about apostrophes for possession, contractions and extending sentences using conjunctions.

HISTORY

This term will be focusing our Theme lessons on history and looking at 'Harborough at War'. We will examine the causes of World War 2 and the effect the war had on the people living in Market Harborough. We will learn about jobs during the war, evacuees, how to stay safe and rationing. To end the unit, we will visit some significant memorials in Market Harborough and reflect on why they are they are so important.



MATHS

This term, we will revise our skills related to money, sorting, recognising and totalling coins as well as learning how to give change. We will begin our unit on multiplication by making equal groups before introducing the x symbol. We will focus on the 2, 5 and 10 times tables and use Times Tables Rockstars to consolidate our skills. The children will solve problems, find patterns and deepen their understanding.
